
Prior to MASP, Drees held senior positions in strategy, business development and

SCOTT O'NEIL Executive Director, IWVEDC

Mr. Scott O'Neil is currently the Executive Director of the Indian Wells Economic Development Valley Corporation. He is the proprietor of S. M. O'Neil Consulting, LLC; and, a member of the Naval Research Advisory Committee, an independent civilian scientific advisory dedicated to providing senior Navy leadership objective analyses in the areas of science, research and development. He retired from U.S. Government civilian service January 2016 after working for the Navy for 43 years. For the decade prior to his retirement Mr. O'Neil served as Executive Director and Director for Research and Engineering of the Naval Air Warfare Center Weapons Division (NAWCWD) at China Lake, California. The Center is responsible for research, development, acquisition support, test,



evaluation, and in-service engineering for naval weapon systems. As Executive Director, Mr. O'Neil directed a highly technical civilian workforce of about 5200 employees.

In November 1998 Mr. O'Neil was appointed as the head of NAWCWD Weapons and Targets Department. In April 2002 he was assigned Director of Atlantic Ranges and Facilities of Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division, at Patuxent River, Maryland. From May through December 2010 he was assigned acting Deputy Commander Naval Air Systems Command.

Prior to moving into general management, Mr. O'Neil conducted research and development in solid rocket propulsion and thrust vector control systems. He was program manager for Vertical Launch ASROC (VLA), an in-house government advanced development program. VLA was made Fleet operational 1993. He was Deputy Program Manager for Tomahawk Cruise Missile rocket motors and he led the development MK 111 Improved Rocket Motor and the WDU36 lightweight warhead system for Tomahawk.














Rear Adm. Corey is a native of Granite City, III. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in chemical engineering and a commission as an ensign from the Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps at the University of Illinois. He is a distinguished graduate of the U.S. Naval Test Pilot School and holds a Master of Arts degree in national security and strategic studies from the Naval War College.

Corey served operationally as an F/A-18 pilot in Strike Fighter Squadron (VFA) 86 deployed in USS America (CV 66), VFA-146 deployed in USS Nimitz (CVN 68), and command of VFA-192 forward deployed in USS Kitty Hawk (CV 63) to Japan. During these tours he participated in operations Desert Storm, Southern Watch, Provide Hope, Deny Flight, Operation Iraqi Freedom several Western and



deployments.

His shore tours include service as a selectively retained graduate (SERGRAD) flight instructor with Training Air Wing Two and the Office of the Chief of Naval Operations (OPNAV) staff where he served as the F/A-18 requirements officer and as the deputy

Ms. Johnson directs a civilian workforce of more than 4,600 professionals.

With more than 30 years of experience in both the private sector and as a civilian with the Department of Defense, Ms. Johnson began her career in industry as an engineer in Electronic Warfare Research and Development. She continued to work as both a software engineer and a systems engineer, developing and integrating software and systems solutions for airborne avionics and Electronic Warfare systems. Ms.




Johnson also served as Engineering Program Manager and Software Engineering Department Manager for teams developing Electronic Warfare suites for the U.S. Navy, Army and Air Force.

Ms. Johnson was hired into the government in February 2000 at NAWCWD China Lake. She worked for the Systems Engineering Department, leading independent program

assessments of NAVAIR softwareintensive acquisition programs. Captain Dale is a 1994 graduate of the University of Michigan (Ann Arbor) with a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering. He earned his Surface Warfare Officer designation then subsequently earned selection for lateral transfer followed ultimately by Naval Flight Officer wings in 1998.

Captain Dale's command tour occurred from February 2012 to May 2013 as Commanding Officer of VAW-116, the "Sun Kings", located at Naval Base Ventura County flying the E-2C

Hawkeye 2000.

His at-sea tours prior to his Command tour involved duties on an Aegis Cruiser and two E-2C squadrons.






