



COMBINED PFA AND FAW



A safe working environment is a basic right for all workers and a responsibility of all employers. This three-day combined Paediatric First Aid & First Aid at Work course covers a range of CPR and first aid skills for both adults and paediatrics, providing employers and your staff with the skills to reduce the risks and dangers in your workplace. The course has endorsed CPD points by CIMSPA and is in line with the First Aid Awarding Organisation Forum (FAAOF).

WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

The Combined FAW & PFA qualification is recommended for everyone, providing first-aiders with the skills to apply first aid to a range of specific injuries and illnesses in adults and children.

Individuals and organisations are advised to take this course, and it's suitable for all industries where children and adults are present and enables companies to meet their first aid needs assessment and HSE requirements.

Candidates must be a minimum of 16 years of age at the time of taking the assessment.

No prior first aid knowledge is required.

WHAT DOES IT INVOLVE?

The Combined FAW & PFA qualification is 22 hours and can be delivered over three consecutive days or split into smaller sessions over a 7 week period from the start of the course.

The course content covers a wide range of CPR and first aid skills, equipping the first-aider to assess, manage and administer first aid to a casualty.

The course comprises practical work and theoretical classroom work, as well as a practical assessment of CPR and first aid.

NEXT STEPS...

Upon qualifying, the candidate will receive a PFA and a FAW certificate that is valid for three years. To renew, a candidate must attend a full Combined PFA & FAW course again.

The next step is to complete other first aid courses, including the Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Programme, Anaphylaxis Management, or become First Aid Trainer.
