"Lord, I have <u>heard</u> of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, Lord."


The Response: The Call to Faith – Turning the Prevailing Mood Around Faith is trusting in God's words, God's ways and God's character no matter the situation.


3. The Outcome: The Power of Hearing of God's Fame. Rom. 10:17 - "Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

- **4** His splendor was like the sunrise; rays flashed from his hand, where his power was hidden.
- 5 Plague went before him; pestilence followed his steps.
- **6** He stood, and shook the earth; he looked, and made the nations tremble.
