Board of Directors Nominations

After the first term as described in the preceding sentence, all subsequent terms shall be for three (3) years.

The Sullivan County Chamber of Commerce is seeking nominations for members willing to be considered to serve on the Board of Directors. All eligible nominees will be considered by the nominating committee, chaired by Heinrich Strauch, Treasurer of the Board.
